"Settling Into Motion" – The Bucerius Ph.D. Scholarship Program in Migration Studies started in 2008 and hosts currently 50 international fellows. It seeks to address the ongoing transformations in societies where migration is just one factor among others generating change. For 2013 proposals studying "Transformation of Migration and Societies" are especially welcome.

Within this international program, the ZEIT-Stiftung Ebelin und Gerd Bucerius grants six to eight Ph.D. scholarships per year. Applicants must be Ph.D. students of – in a broad sense – social sciences. The scholarships involve a monthly stipend of 1.200 Euros as well as yearly conferences and workshops. The deadline for applications is **11 April 2013**.
