Centre for International Cooperation in the framework of Theodor Herzl Distinguished Chair at Masaryk University organizes a seminar for a group of five Central European and five Israeli Doctorate students in <u>Telč</u> during 9-13 July 2017.

All the expanses, including the travel from the home institution, accommodation, meals, rich cultural program, are paid by the organizers.

The main theme of the seminar is **Democracy in crisis: The Democracy and democratic regimes in light of social, political, religious, economic, and security changes.** Since the 20th century, the democratic regimes have stood the test of a variety of processes. These processes influenced the strength of the democratic regimes and shaped their developments. In recent years we have witnessed the strengthening of these processes that raise questions about the future design of the democratic regimes. The seminar will examine the range of impacts and compare the processes taking place in different countries.

Above all, the seminar aims to attract intelligent and open Ph.D. candidates with interest beyond their own respective fields, who want to share their research findings with the likeminded peers from the Central Europe and Israel.

Application requirements are:

The following nationalities are eligible: Israel, Czech Republic, Slovakia, Poland, Austria, Hungary and Germany

- Enrolment at one of universities in the country listed above.
- Each application has to be annexed by a short paper on the given theme
- A letter of support should be provided
