Joint Interdisciplinary Doctoral and Post-Doctoral Program

Call for Applications

"Human Rights under Pressure – Ethics, Law and Politics" (HR-UP), offered together by the Hebrew University of Jerusalem and Freie Universität Berlin, provides an **unprecedented joint platform** for cutting-edge, **fully funded** research in the field of human rights.

HR-UP includes a **3-year structured, interdisciplinary Doctoral Program**, and will welcome its third cohort of doctoral students in **October 2016**. This **interdisciplinary** program welcomes **outstanding candidates** whose research is in relevant fields of Law, Social Sciences or the Humanities, including Social Work and Education. Doctoral fellowships will include a monthly stipend of approx. €1,365, plus mobility costs and material expenses.

HR-UP offers **two post-doctoral fellowships per year** (one per location). The year-long fellowships include a monthly stipend of €1,750, and are open to researchers who received their doctorate no earlier than September 2012 or will submit their dissertation no later than March 2016. Fellows commit to completing a **significant research project** dealing with the challenges confronting human rights, relevant to the HR-UP research program, during the 2016-2017 academic year, and to present it at academic events.

All participants take part in **joint courses and workshops** - including an introductory symposium in Jerusalem, annual summer schools in Berlin, and biweekly interdisciplinary colloquia— and are **jointly supervised** by participating senior scholars from Germany and Israel. Doctoral fellows spend a **4-8 month mobility period** at the other university during their time in the program.
