

Call for Postdoctoral Fellowships for the 2026 academic year

The HBBH at the University of Haifa is pleased to announce a postdoctoral fellowship program for outstanding candidates in the field of brain and behavioral research.

The scholarship will be awarded for one year and will be NIS 100,000 per academic year (out of this amount, the receiving advisor undertakes to cover NIS 20,000).

Applicants will take an active part in the activities of HBBH, including participation in lectures, conferences and teaching.

Prerequisites for applying:

Those with PhD eligibility after October 1, 2021 – no later than 4 years after completing their doctoral studies – from recognized universities in Israel or abroad that have completed their studies at a university other than the University of Haifa.

The application should be submitted through the "Scholarships" tab.

The submission should include the following documents:

- CV includes a list of publications (including the ranking of the journal according to Impact Factor and a link to the article).
- Copy of doctoral certificate and/or certificate attesting to eligibility and date of eligibility for doctoral degree .
- Proposal for the research project written in English with a scope of up to 500 words. The proposal must contain a declaration of intent upon completion of postdoctoral studies.
- A letter of recommendation from the PhD dissertation supervisor.
- An additional letter of recommendation from another academic faculty member.
- A letter of recommendation from the postdoctoral advisor must include a budgetary commitment to complete the scholarship for the scholarship period (in the amount of NIS 20,000 per year).

Sorting procedure:

The screening process will include judging all materials submitted by a committee composed of researchers and members of the HBBH. The committee will consider the research experience, unique skills, academic excellence and relevance of the research proposal to the field of the brain. Reference to these issues should be included in the various letters of recommendation.

Requests where documents are missing will not be considered.

Granting the scholarship in accordance with the regulations of the Graduate Studies Authority, Bloom School.
