Call for Postdoctoral Fellowships for the 2026–2027 Academic Year

The HBBH at the University of Haifa is pleased to announce a postdoctoral fellowship program for outstanding candidates in the field of brain and behavioral research.

The fellowship will be awarded for one academic year in the amount of NIS 100,000 (out of this amount, the hosting advisor is committed to providing NIS 20,000).

Recipients of the fellowship will take an active part in HBBH activities, including participation in lectures, conferences, and teaching.

Eligibility Criteria

Candidates who became eligible for a PhD degree after October 1, 2022 (and no more than four years after completion of their doctoral studies), from recognized universities in Israel or abroad, and who completed their studies at an institution other than the University of Haifa, are eligible to apply. The application is intended only for candidates beginning their first year in the 2026–2027 academic year.

The application should include the following documents:

- Curriculum vitae, including a list of publications formatted according to APA guidelines and the regulations of the Authority for Advanced Studies – Bloom Graduate School (the form can be found [here](#); please download the form and attach it to the submission).
- A copy of the PhD diploma and/or official confirmation of eligibility for the PhD degree, including the date of eligibility.
- A research proposal written in English, up to 500 words in length. The proposal should include a statement of intent regarding plans following completion of the postdoctoral fellowship.
- A letter of recommendation from the PhD dissertation advisor.
- An additional academic letter of recommendation.
- A letter of recommendation from the hosting researcher, including a financial commitment to complete the fellowship funding for the duration of the fellowship (in the amount of NIS 20,000).

Selection Process

The selection process will include evaluation of all submitted materials by a committee composed of researchers affiliated with the HBBH. The committee will consider research experience, unique skills, academic excellence, and the relevance of the research proposal to the field of brain and behavioral research.

Please address these issues in the letters of recommendation.

Applications with missing documents will not be considered.

The fellowship will be awarded in accordance with the regulations of the Authority for Advanced Studies – Bloom Graduate School.
